Eligible applicants must be a European Union student between the ages of 13 and 19 by 25 May 2019

- 2) Upload a VIDEO, TEASER, BIOGRAPHY AND PHOTO, according to the submission guidelines on page 2.

Any incomplete application or video submission automatically disqualifies the applicant.

The video <u>must</u> include opening and ending credits acknowledging contributors, such as writing, music, editing, etc. Also, submit a separate 30-second teaser video and a biography and still photo of yourself. Any application missing one or more of these elements is automatically disqualified.



VIDEO SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

IMPORTANT NOTE: THE VIDEO SUBMITTED TO THE ZAWINUL FOUNDATION FOR ACHIEVEMENT MUST BE SHOT SPECIFICALLY FOR THIS CONTEST (THE JOE ZAWINUL CREATIVE VIDEO AWARD). THE APPLICANT CANNOT USE EXISTING VIDEO FOOTAGE, VIDEO CLIPS, YOUTUBE VIDEOS OR ANY OTHER PREVIOUSLY PRODUCED AND/OR BROADCASTED MATERIAL.

Video requirements:

- ★ The video of your hometown *must not exceed 3 minutes and 20 seconds*, including opening and ending credits.
- * Credits must acknowledge all contributors, including writing, music, editing, etc. Videos without credits are automatically disqualified.
- ★ The video may be shot with any type of camera, but must be submitted as either MP4 or MOV files. All other formats will be rejected.
- ★ Include a *separate* 30-second teaser of the video as a MP4/MOV file. This should reflect the main video's theme, not focused on you, the filmmaker. Submissions missing the teaser are automatically disqualified.

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Biography requirements:

- \star Send a brief, one- to two-paragraph biography of yourself as a Word or PDF file. In the bio, tell us:
 - Your name
 - Age
 - School name
 - What inspires you
 - What you find most rewarding about filmmaking
- ★ Include a high-resolution (300+ dpi) still photo of yourself (not embedded in a Word or PDF file)
